

ROADS ACT 1993

Order – Section 46

Redeclaration of roads in the Corowa area in association with the opening of the Federation Bridge over the Murray River near Corowa

I, the Minister for Transport, pursuant to Section 46 of the Roads Act, by this Order:

- a) Vary the routes of Main Road No 86, 314 and 550 by revoking the existing declarations of Main Roads Nos 86, 314 and 550 and declaring as Main Roads Nos 86, 314 and 550, the roads described in the schedule below, and
- b) Revoke the declaration of Main Road No 250.

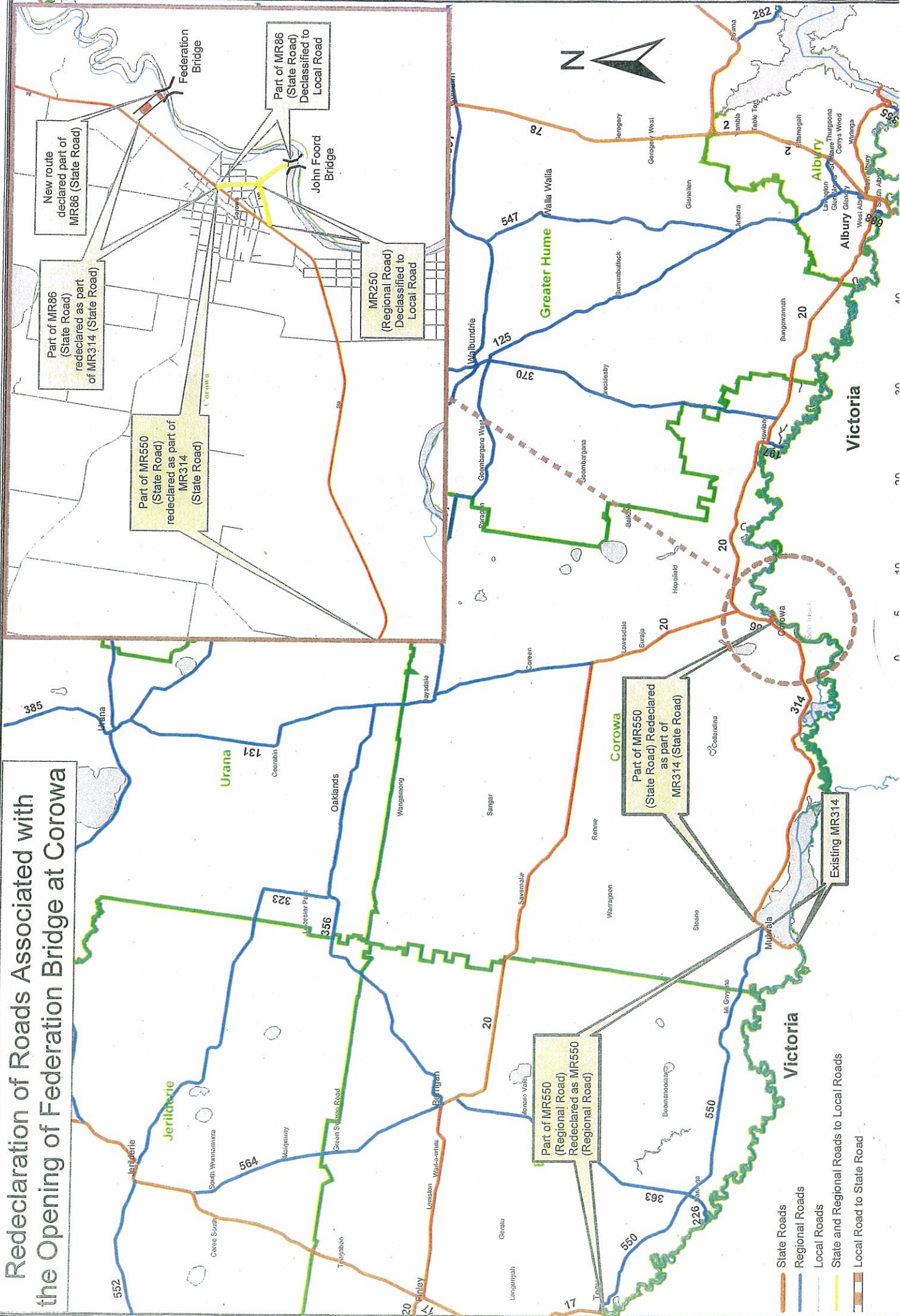

CLASS, NAME and NUMBER	DESCRIPTION	<i>Administrative Category</i>
Main Road No 86	From the Victorian border via Federation Bridge over the Murray River northeast of Corowa, to the Riverina Highway (HW20) northeast of Corowa.	<i>State</i>
Main Road No 314	From the Corowa – Albury Road (MR86) at Corowa to the Victorian border via Mulwala Bridge over the Murray River, at Mulwala.	<i>State</i>
Main Road No 550	From the Corowa – Mulwala Road (MR314) north of Mulwala via Barooga to the Newell Highway (HW17) at Tocumwal.	<i>Regional</i>
