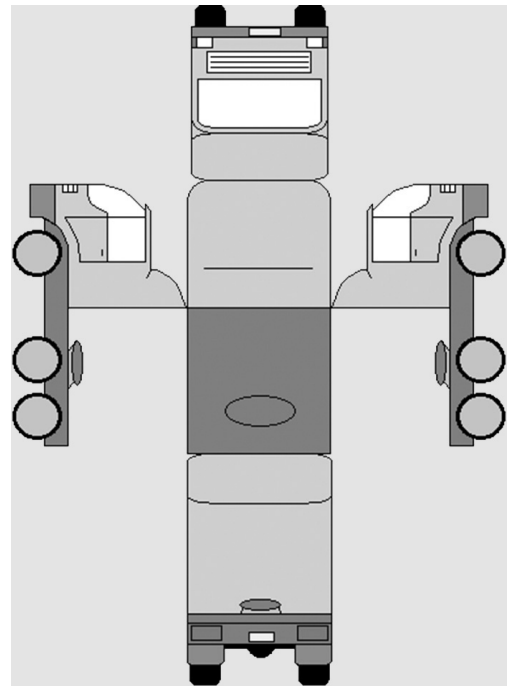

(viii) I have kept a copy of this certification and the corresponding repair guidelines for my records. I will keep this record for a period of seven (7) years from the issue date. A copy of this certificate and all other records associated with this certification will be produced upon request, to an authorised officer of the NSW Police Force, Transport for NSW and/or NSW Fair Trading in the course of any investigation.
