



AIS – Application for Police Approval to Conduct Brake Tests on Public Roads

To the local Police Traffic Section,

Under Roads and Maritime Services' Rules for the Authorised Inspection Scheme, proprietor's must obtain Police approval to conduct brake tests on public roads. This form is to get approval from the local Police station for brake tests to be conducted on the proposed road public road by authorised examiners operating at this station.

5. Police permission to test brakes

Required if an efficiency meter will be used on public roads

Under the provisions of the Road Transport Act 2013; the applicant may test the vehicle's brakes on the road/s named below, provided the tests are carried out in daylight. In conducting these tests, the applicant must comply with all traffic laws and obey any police directions. This permission may be withdrawn at any time. The police will not be liable for any consequences of the test.
