

APPLICATION FOR PERSONAL WATERCRAFT DRIVING LICENCE

An Application for a Personal Watercraft (PWC) Driving Licence must be submitted to Transport for NSW following successful completion of a PWC knowledge test, when applying to renew a PWC or when applying for a replacement PWC photo card.

All applicants for a PWC Driving Licence must provide acceptable proof of identity documents and have their identity verified by an acceptable signatory. Acceptable signatories are any Police Officer, Justice of the Peace, Judge, Magistrate, Bank Manager, Legal Practitioner, School Principal or Service NSW officer. Initial PWC licence applicants can also have their proof of identity verified by the Authorised Training Provider where the test was successfully completed.

TO COMPLETE THE FORM

1. Provide 2 passport acceptable colour photographs (35mm x 45mm). Other photos will not be accepted.
2. Print your surname and date of birth on the back of the photos. Press lightly so as not to indent the photo.
3. Glue one photo to the form in the space provided. Attach the second photo to this form using a paper clip only. Do not use pins, tape, or staples.
4. Complete the Licensee's details section below and have your proof of identity verified.
5. Payment can be mailed or made in person at any Service NSW Centre.
