

2019 Easter Long Weekend Travel Requirements

Agricultural Vehicles

Roads and Maritime Services | March 2019

Travel restrictions apply for oversize agricultural vehicles, such as tractors and headers, during the Easter long weekend. These requirements are outlined in [Appendix 2 of the NSW Class 1 Agricultural Vehicles Notice 2015](#) and additional requirements for vehicles operating under an access permit in the [Additional Access Conditions for oversize and overmass heavy vehicles and loads](#). This document provides an overview of the Easter long weekend travel requirements.

Night time requirements

There is no change to night travel requirements for oversize agricultural vehicles during the Easter long weekend.

Oversize agricultural vehicles are unable to travel at night if they are wider than 2.5 metres or longer than 22 metres under the [NSW Class 1 Agricultural Vehicles Notice 2015](#).

Night travel access permits are available for oversize hay balers and grape harvesters to travel at night.

Day time requirements

Oversize agricultural vehicles can travel in the day time on the Easter long weekend, subject to additional pilot requirements for travel in the NSW Urban, Eastern and Western Zones between 19 April 2019 and 22 April 2019 on some roads.

NSW Urban and Eastern Zones

Oversize agricultural vehicles travelling on the following roads (a vehicle driving across the road is exempted) from sunrise 19 April 2019 to sunset

22 April 2019 must be accompanied by at least one pilot vehicle during this period:

**Note: There is no oversize travel on weekends on the Kings Highway between Braidwood and Batemans Bay during November, December, January and February.

Oversize agricultural vehicles travelling on the following roads (a vehicle driving across the road is exempted) from sunrise 19 April 2019 to sunset 22 April 2019 must be accompanied by at least one pilot vehicle:
