

## Maintenance work on Barrington Bridge, Barrington from Monday 5 November

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on Barrington Bridge over the Barrington River on Thunderbolts Way to ensure continued safe operation of the bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out the work, which includes bolt tightening, timber replacement and the installation of a steel plate on the bridge deck.

We will be working between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and expect to complete the work in **two weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

We are also continuing to plan for the new bridge with early work activities underway and main construction activities expected to start in 2019.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

Intermittent delays may occur and motorists should allow up to 15 minutes extra travel time.
