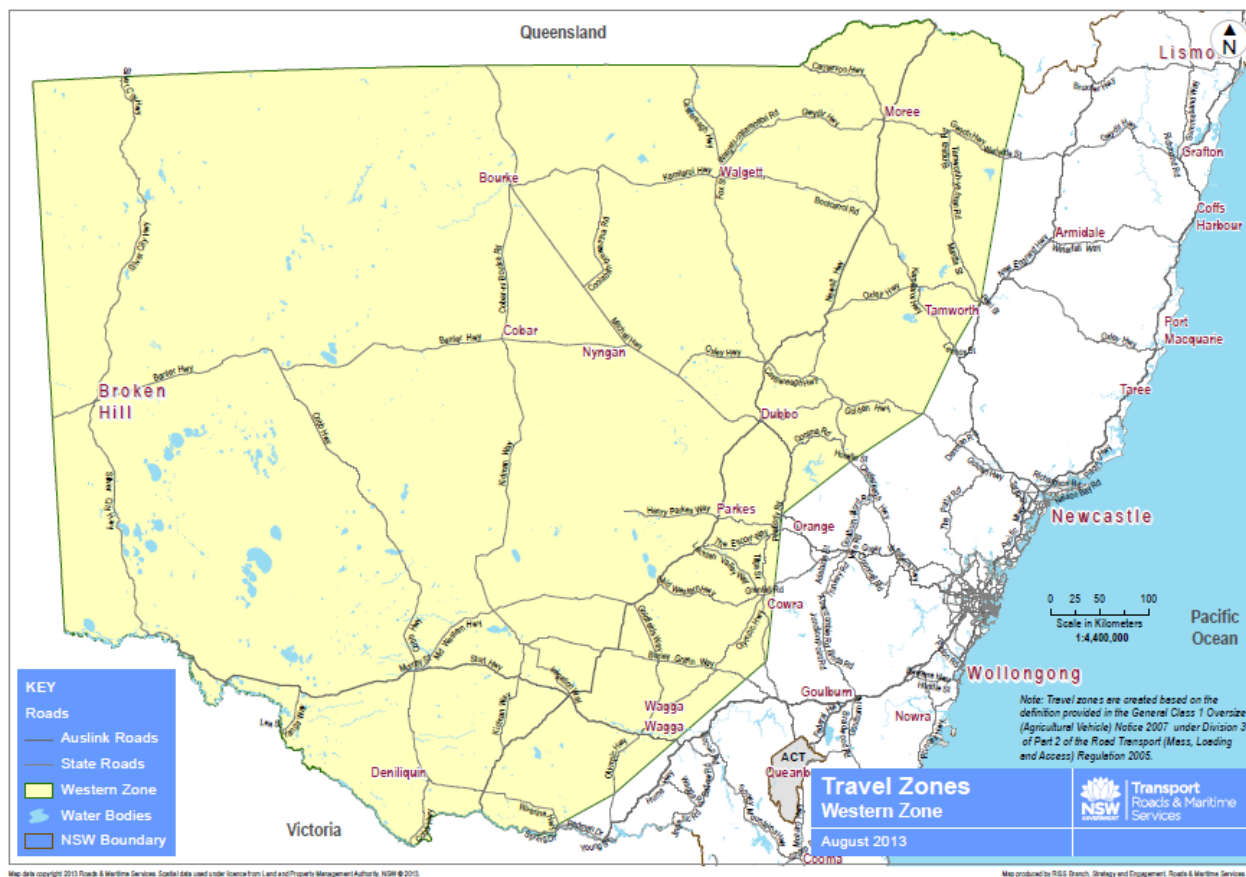


NSW Travel Zones



Western Zone



The NSW Western Zone is that part of the State of New South Wales that is not part of the area declared to be the NSW Urban Zone or Eastern Zone, included within the Class 1 Agricultural Vehicles (Amendment) Notice 2012.

This zone is bounded to the east by a line drawn through Corowa, Culcairn, Boorowa, Molong, Mudgee, Merriwa, Quirindi, Tamworth, Bundarra and Inverell to the Queensland border adjacent to the intersection of the Bonshaw–Emmaville Road and the Bruxner Highway (HW16) east of Bonshaw.

Eastern Zone



The Eastern Zone is that part of NSW west of the NSW Urban Zone and east of a line drawn through Corowa, Culcairn, Boorowa, Molong, Mudgee, Merriwa, Quirindi, Tamworth, Bundarra, Inverell to the intersection of the Tenterfield to Boggabilla Road (RR462) and Bonshaw Road (RR137).
