Barton Highway upgrade

Temporary traffic changes at Briarwood Lane, Nanima and Spring Range roads

The Australian and NSW governments are investing in the Barton Highway upgrade to improve safety and journey reliability for all road users, ease congestion and boost freight productivity.

What are we doing?

Work is progressing on the new two-lane northbound carriageway for the first stage of the Barton Highway upgrade. As part of this upgrade, we have started upgrading the intersections at Briarwood Lane, Nanima and Spring Range roads. These intersections will be built with suitable median crossovers for large vehicle access and U-turn facilities, improving access and safety.

As we build these new intersections, our work activities will include clearing and earthworks, installing kerb and guttering, new stormwater drainage, new pavement and line marking.

When are we working?

Work will take about **four months** and is expected to be completed by the end of August, weather permitting.

Our work hours are between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** and **1pm** **Saturday, excluding public holidays.**

There may be a need to carry out some work at night to reduce impacts on traffic. Nearby residents will be notified in advance of this work.

How will the work affect you?

Work will involve the use of machinery that will generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe for both residents and workers. Traffic may be switched onto new and temporary pavement while we build these new intersections.

Resident access will be maintained while this work is carried out.

Existing bus stops at these locations will remain in place, however, may be moved temporarily to another location within the intersection while construction work is carried out.

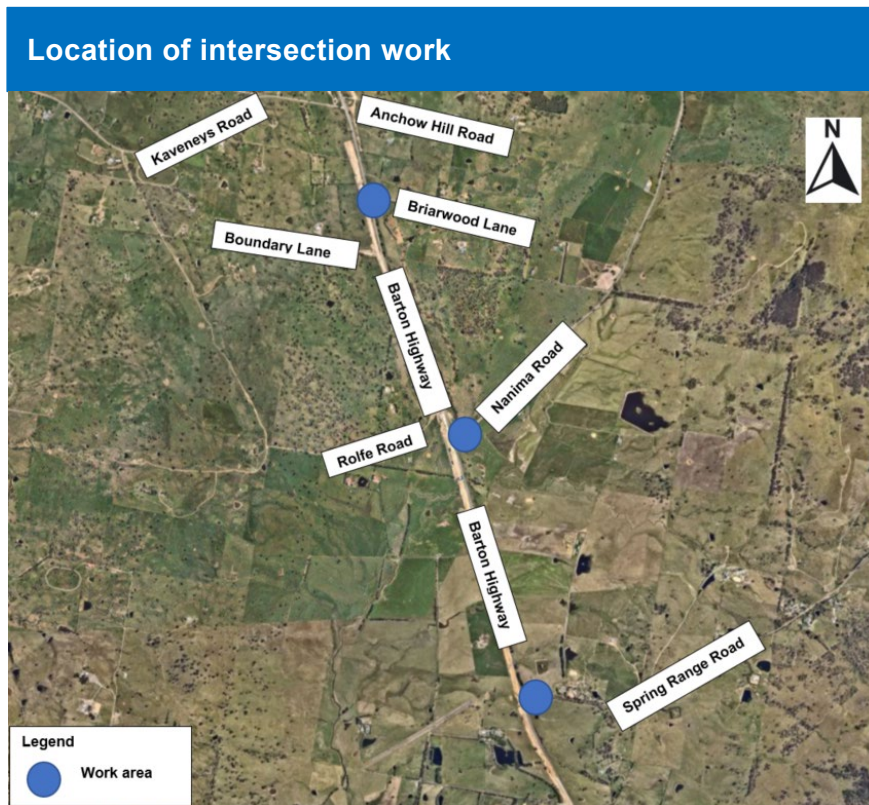
