

Relocating traffic island at North Street and Clyde Street intersection, Batemans Bay

Transport for NSW is relocating a traffic island at the North Street and Clyde Street intersection from 23 November to improve pedestrian safety and access for transport users.

What are we doing?

As part of the Batemans Bay Bridge replacement project, the traffic island at the North Street and Clyde Street intersection will be relocated closer to the southern side of the road to enable long vehicles travelling on North Street to safely access Clyde Street.

Vehicles over 8.8 metres in length will no longer be permitted to turn right into North Street from Clyde Street. Long vehicles traveling south on Clyde Street east will need to continue on Orient Street to the Beach Road intersection.

What you need to know?

This work will take five days to complete and include new line marking on Clyde Street and new traffic signs. It will be carried out between **Monday 23 November** and **Friday 27 November 2020**, during normal **construction hours from 7am to 6pm, weather permitting.**

For road users, temporary traffic changes will be in place for motorists while work is carried out. This will include the temporary closure of the westbound lane of North Street from Clyde Street through to Perry Street. Motorists travelling on Clyde Street will not be permitted to turn right into North Street, and can continue through Orient Street. Parking will be maintained along the eastbound lane of North Street. Parking will not be permitted within the work zone along the westbound lane.

For long vehicles, the North Street westbound lane will be reinstated to vehicles less than 8.8 metres long outside of work hours each day. Vehicles over 8.8 metres long will need to continue on Orient Street to Beach Road.


For pedestrians, access will be maintained along footpaths on both sides of North Street via a temporary pedestrian detour.

A diagram showing the temporary traffic and pedestrian changes is available on the back page.




