

## We have updated our plan to maintain Clyde River boat ramp access during construction of the Batemans Bay Bridge replacement project

Access to the Clyde River will alternate between Clyde Street boat ramp and Old Punt Road boat ramp during major work of the new Batemans Bay Bridge to deliver continuous river access for boat users and ensure the safety of river users and workers at all times.

### What are we doing?

We will alternate access between the Old Punt Road boat ramp and Clyde Street boat ramp during construction to allow for the efficient delivery of major work.

Old Punt Road boat ramp will be reopened on **25 September 2020**, weather permitting.

Clyde Street boat ramp will be closed the following day on **26 September 2020** to ensure one boat ramp is accessible at all times during construction.

River access will continue to alternate between the two existing boat ramps throughout major work and the community will be informed ahead of these changes.

Signage will be in place at both boat ramps to keep the community informed. Boat users can also subscribe for specific updates regarding boat ramp access via email and text message by contacting the project team at [BatemansBayBridge@jhq.com.au](mailto:BatemansBayBridge@jhq.com.au) or 1800 870 119.

To safely build the new bridge, we require use of the northern and southern foreshore areas of the Clyde River during construction. To minimise impacts to our community and river users, boat ramp access will be maintained at alternate times into the Clyde River during construction.

A temporary boat ramp will not be constructed at Korners Park and this location will be used to assist with the construction of the new bridge.

## What you need to know

Both Old Punt Road boat ramp and Clyde Street boat ramp will each provide up to **eight** boat trailer parking spaces, a safe boat holding location, and a boat trailer turn-around area.

River users may continue to use Hanging Rock boat ramp in Batemans Bay and Nelligen Boat ramps in Nelligen throughout major work. Hanging Rock boat ramp provides access to open water and can be accessed along Beach Road towards Batehaven; about a five minute drive from Batemans Bay town centre.

The Wharf Street boat ramp on the western bank in Nelligen provides parking facilities and a floating jetty for access.
