

## Widening vehicle turn-around area in Clyde Street west, Batemans Bay

Transport for NSW is widening the vehicle turn-around area at the western end of Clyde Street from 4 January 2021 to improve long vehicle movements for transport users.

### What are we doing?

As part of the Batemans Bay Bridge replacement project, the turn-around area at the western end of Clyde Street west will be upgraded allowing long vehicles travelling west on Clyde Street to safely complete a turn and continue east along Clyde Street.

### What you need to know?

This work will start from **Monday 4 January 2021** and will take up to six weeks to complete, weather permitting. The work includes drainage relocation, replacement of kerbing, asphaltting, line marking and installation of new traffic signs. This work is required as part of Clyde Street realignment activities, which will connect the road beneath the new Batemans Bay Bridge once it opens to traffic.

Work will take place during standard construction hours from **Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm, and on Saturday between 8am and 1pm.**

**For road users, local residents, visitors and workers**, temporary traffic changes will be in place for motorists while work is carried out. This will include permanent removal of three parallel parking spaces and temporary construction impacts to 14 perpendicular car parking spaces around the turning area at the western end of Clyde Street, including the single loading bay near the private jetty.

Remaining parallel and perpendicular parking spaces along Clyde Street west and east will be available during this work. In addition, Clyde Street boat ramp will be open with 8 boat and trailer parking spaces available.

Traffic control will be in place and parking will not be permitted within the work zone.

Property and private jetty access to the Clyde River will be maintained at all times.

**For pedestrians**, access will be maintained along the southern side of Clyde Street west and clear signage will be in place.

Motorists and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control. Transport for NSW thanks motorists and pedestrians for their patience during this time.


