

Temporary pedestrian detour at Old Punt Road, Batemans Bay

Transport for NSW is temporarily changing how pedestrians access Batemans Bay from Old Punt Road from 27 January, to allow work to continue on the Batemans Bay Bridge replacement.

What are we doing?

A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place between Old Punt Road and Batemans Bay during the construction of a new roundabout at Old Punt Road, removal of the northern bridge support of the existing bridge and connection of Wharf Road to Old Punt Road.

What do you need to know?

The temporary pedestrian detour is required to ensure the safety of the community and workers and will be in place from **Wednesday 27 January for up to six months**, weather permitting.

The detour will allow us to carry out work including earthworks, drainage, new kerbing installation, road surfacing and new line marking. Construction of new boat trailer and car parking on the northern foreshore will also be carried out during the pedestrian detour.

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours from **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**, and on **Saturday** between **8am** and **1pm**.

The temporary pedestrian access from Old Punt Road to Batemans Bay is shown on the map on the back page.

Clear signage will be in place and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control. We thank the community for their patience during this time.
