Project update

December 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are delivering the Belmore Road ramps project to improve access to and from the M5 South-West Motorway at Riverwood for local residents and businesses.

Since our August 2018 update we have completed a number of milestones for the project such as widening the existing eastbound off ramp, installing new drainage and installing the tolling gantries for the new ramps.

The ramps are expected to open to traffic in early 2019.

What is happening next

To complete construction we will be:

- Completing work, including asphaltting and line marking on Belmore Road, the existing eastbound off ramp and the new east facing ramps
- Installing new traffic lights on Belmore Road
- Installing new signage on Belmore Road and the M5 South-West Motorway
- Utility relocation work
- Landscaping.

Clearway

Roads and Maritime is working closely with the Canterbury Bankstown Council to install a new weekday clearway southbound along Belmore Road.

Signage for the new clearway between Hannans Road and Roosevelt Street will be installed in the New Year. The length of the clearway has been shortened to enable us to maintain the existing pedestrian refuge just south of Roosevelt Street. Once the signage is installed the clearway will be operational from Monday to Friday in the afternoon peak between 4pm and 7pm.

We will notify you again before the signage is installed.

Our work schedule

We will not carry out work during the Christmas and New Year holidays **Saturday 22 December 2018** until **Wednesday 2 January 2019**.

Our work hours will be from **7am to 6pm** on **weekdays**, and from **8am to 5pm** on **Saturday**.

Our night work hours are from **8pm to 6am** between **Mondays** and **Sundays**. Night work will be intermittent and no night work will be carried out on Friday or Saturday evenings or on public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy and include extra lighting, however we will do everything we can to minimise its impact including completing noisier work earlier in the evening and directing lights away from residential areas.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

For safety reasons, a reduced speed limit of 80 km/hour is in place on the M5 South-West Motorway for the duration of the project. While we are not working, the reduced speed limit will remain in place to ensure the safety of motorists travelling through the work zone.


