

Changed traffic conditions and night work on Princes Highway at Bomaderry from Monday 10 May

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be making changes to south bound traffic conditions on the Princes Highway at Bomaderry. To make these changes we will be carrying out safety barrier relocation and line marking activities on the Princes Highway on **Monday 10 May**, weather permitting. Work will be carried out between **6pm** and **6am** to minimise the impact to motorists. Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs.

On **Tuesday 11 May**, all southbound traffic will be diverted onto the new southbound carriageway between Abernethys Lane and Cambewarra Road. Northbound traffic will continue to travel in a single lane from Cambewarra Road towards Berry. The two traffic lanes will be separated by the median.

From **Tuesday 11 May** we will also begin work on a missing section of footpath on the eastern side of the Highway, just north of the Cambewarra and Moss Vale Road intersection. Property access will be maintained at all times during this work.

How will the work affect you?

There will be noise and light associated with this work however we will make every effort to minimise disruption to residents.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
