Temporary closure of Cowpasture Road (south), Leppington from Saturday, 9 September 2017

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding this work under the \$509 million Bringelly Road Upgrade between Camden Valley Way, Leppington and The Northern Road, Bringelly. This project is part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out work to upgrade the intersection of Bringelly Road and Cowpasture Road (south), Leppington. As part of this work, a section of Cowpasture Road (south) will be closed to build the new westbound traffic lanes on Bringelly Road.

The temporary road closure will be in place from **7am, Saturday, 9 September** through to **6pm Monday 11 September 2017**, weather permitting, when traffic volumes are lower.

We have included a map to show the location of work and the changed traffic arrangements.

Traffic changes

Cowpasture Road (south) between Bringelly Road and Camden Valley Way will be closed.

Alternate access will be available via Ingleburn Road, Rickard Road and Camden Valley Way at Leppington. Access for local residents will be maintained at all times.

Electronic message signs will be in place to advise road users of changes.


