Safety improvements on Brisbane Water Drive at the Sunshine Drive and Sunnyside Avenue intersections, Point Clare from Sunday 24 June

The NSW Government has provided \$600,000 this financial year for safety improvements on Brisbane Water Drive between Glenrock Parade and Manooka Road.

Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback in May on proposed safety improvements at Sunshine Drive and Sunnyside Avenue and will now be going ahead with the work. The project is part of a broader program of work addressing safety issues along this section of Brisbane Water Drive at Point Clare.

We received 43 responses to the request for feedback, with the majority in favour of the proposal which involves:

- installing right turn bays on Brisbane Water Drive to help motorists turning into Sunshine Drive and Sunnyside Avenue
- implementing a no stopping zone along this section of Brisbane Water Drive and removing the eastbound bus stop located west of Byarong Avenue, to allow enough space for new turning bays to be installed.

A number of responses were received to modify the proposed upgrade, including a proposal to install a dedicated right turn acceleration lane out of Sunnyside Avenue and Sunshine Drive. We investigated this suggestion but an acceleration lane cannot be provided due to the existing road width.

We have responded directly to all questions and concerns raised and thank everyone for providing feedback. After considering all responses, we have decided to proceed with the proposal with minor changes including extending the no stopping zone east on Brisbane Water drive to about 20 metres past Byarong Avenue on both sides of the road.

Work details

To minimise the impact on traffic, the work will be carried out at night. We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** on **Sunday 24 June** and **Monday 25 June**, weather permitting.

We have provided a map to show the location of work.

How will the work affect you?

The work will generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise and disturbance during the work by carrying out noisier activities before **11pm**.

Traffic changes


Traffic control will be in place which may affect travel times. Traffic in both directions on Brisbane Water Drive will be stopped intermittently for up to five minutes at a time to allow work to be completed safely.
