



# Burrill Lake Bridge replacement

## Project completed

**March 2018**

Construction of the \$58 million Burrill Lake Bridge replacement, Princes Highway upgrade is now complete.

Since opening the new bridge to traffic in late 2017, we have recently removed the old bridge and causeway, completed roundabouts, completed local road accesses, completed parking spaces, completed pedestrian and cycle paths, completed landscaping and the southern foreshore community platform. Lions Park will be completed when the site office is removed in April 2018.

### **A tribute to the old lake crossing**

The southern section of the old bridge has been transformed into a foreshore park for the community to enjoy. The plaque from the old causeway will also be presented to the Milton and Ulladulla Historical Society.
