Dear resident/ business owner,

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is planning for the future upgrade of **Campbelltown Road between Camden Valley Way at Casula and Brooks Road at Denham Court**. The concept design and review of environmental factors (REF) are on display for comment until Friday 31 May 2013.

This road will be an essential link in servicing Sydney's South West Growth Centre. Traffic volumes are predicted to double by 2026 in line with housing development in the growth centre. The proposed works aim to meet these needs by upgrading this section of road from a generally two-lane road to a four-lane divided road.

Unfortunately, there have been a number of errors with the distribution of Community Update newsletters about the upgrade, and RMS would like to apologise for any inconvenience this has caused. The consultation period has been extended until Friday 31 May 2013 to allow more time for the community to provide comments. Information on having your say is provided below.

RMS will respond to all written feedback received in a formal submissions report, which will be prepared after 31 May 2013 and will be published on the project website in the coming months.

RMS would like to thank those who have already provided feedback or asked questions about the project. We have attached a question and answer sheet to address some of the key issues raised so far.
