**Re: Campbelltown Road Upgrade  
Camden Valley Way, Casula to Brooks Road, Denham Court**

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is planning and designing for a future upgrade of Campbelltown Road between Camden Valley Way at Casula and Brooks Road at Denham Court forming a main route in Sydney's South West Growth Centre.

Campbelltown Road is one of the state roads in the South West Growth Centre requiring an upgrade to accommodate the future land uses and traffic planned for the area. This planning work is funded by the NSW Government.

## **Project features**

- Widen Campbelltown Road to four lanes (two lanes in each direction) with a wide central median.
- The wide central median would allow for further widening to six lanes (three lanes in each direction) in the future.
- Early works to widen part of Campbelltown Road in the vicinity of Edmondson Park town centre are proposed by UrbanGrowth formerly Landcom as part of its precinct development work.
- Three new intersections with traffic signals would provide improved access to the Edmondson Park precinct and town centre including the new railway station and bus interchange.
- The existing roundabout at Denham Court Road would be replaced with traffic signals at the intersection.
- An additional bridge over F5 Freeway/Hume Highway to allow for the widening of Campbelltown Road.
- Improve safety by providing a divided carriageway, shared path and pedestrian crossings at traffic lights.
- Improve public transport by providing better access to Edmondson Park station on the South West Rail Link.
- Enhanced urban design, including landscaping, an off-road shared pedestrian and bicycle path, integrated with the planning for Edmondson Park.

During 2012, planning continued for the environmental impact assessment and concept design, which will be displayed for community comment and feedback in the first half of 2013. Following environmental approval, the project would progress to the detailed design phase.
