## Continuing work on Carrington Road and Showground Road, Castle Hill from 1 September

August 2021

The Australian Government and NSW Governments are taking action to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion and improving safety for all road users.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersections of Showground Road at Carrington Road and De Clambe Drive and widening Showground Road and Carrington Road to provide extra turning lanes and bus lanes.

Along the northern side Showground Road and western side of Carrington Road we will:

- remove sections of road and footpath to carry out drainage and utility works
- rebuild footpath removed on Showground Road and Carrington Road
- carry out various utility works
- install a new storm water drainage system along Showground Road and Carrington Road
- resurface and asphalt road

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for **78 day** and **64 night shifts** between **Wednesday 1 September** and **Tuesday 30 November**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from Monday to Friday and between **8am** and **1pm** on Saturday.

Night work will be carried out between **7pm** and **5am** from Sunday to Thursday the next day. We will work up to five nights per week.

We will not work on public holidays.

## Temporary change to our night work hours

With current stay-at-home orders in place and less movement on the roads, we will temporarily adjust our work schedule to extend our night work hours.

The roads are still too busy to carry out all our work during the day safely so we will need to continue to work **five night shifts** a week from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

Our night work will now be conducted between the hours of **7pm** and **5am**, finishing noisier activity by **midnight**.

The night work hours will be changed to the standard hours when the stay-at-home orders are eased. We will keep our community informed of any changes.

## How will the work affect you?

Where possible some of our work will be carried out during the day, however, we will need to carry out some of this work at night to lessen the disruption on traffic and for the safety of our workers.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the southern side of Showground Road and the eastern side of Carrington Road.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to reduce the disturbance, including completing noisier activities by midnight.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours for the widening works and for the work zone to be safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
