Changes to our work hours from Monday 15 August 2021

The Australian Government and NSW Governments are taking action to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion and improving safety for all road use

In line with the NSW Government announcement on Wednesday 28 July 2021, construction activities on the Showground Road upgrade recommenced on Wednesday 4 August 2021.

Our work will be carried out in line with the latest health and safety requirements and with COVID safe practices to keep our workers and the community safe.

We made arrangements to safely restart our work activities from Wednesday 4 August 2021. Should these restrictions change based on advice by the NSW Government, which may impact the timing of our work, the community will be notified. We encourage you to visit our website at nswroads.work/Showgroundcarrington to stay up to date with our work activities.

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. Please be assured our people and worksites follow NSW Health's COVID-19 requirements and will continue to do so.

Our work schedule is temporarily changing

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersections of Showground Road at Carrington Road and De Clambe Drive and widening Showground Road and Carrington Road to provide extra turning lanes and bus lanes.

With current stay-at-home orders in place and less movement on the roads, we will temporarily adjust our work schedule to extend our daily working hours. This will assist the project in meeting our expected completion date and minimise the ongoing impacts of our work on community.

From **Monday 15 August** we will adjust our work schedule.

Day work

We will continue to work **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**.

We are aware residents are working from home and will do everything we can to limit the disturbance. Where possible, we will direct noise-generating equipment away from properties and turn vehicles and machinery off when not in use.

If required, we will also work **Saturdays** between **7am** and **5pm** and **Sunday** from **9am** and **5pm**.

Night work

The roads are still too busy to conduct all our work during the day safely. We will continue to work **five night shifts** a week from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

Our night work will now be conducted between the hours of **7pm** and **5am**, finishing noisier activity by **midnight**.



How long will the new work schedule changes last?

The new temporary work schedule allows us to work extra hours on the road, which has only been made possible during the evolving Coronavirus situation during the current stay-at-home orders. At this stage, it is estimated this will continue through until **Monday 30 August 2021**.
