## Chiswick Wharf upgrade

### Wharf reopening on Monday 31 July.

The new Chiswick Wharf will open on Monday 31 July.

Parramatta River ferry services will operate regular services from the upgraded wharf. The temporary shuttle bus, route 437, to Abbotsford Wharf will stop.

The first F3 Parramatta River service departs Chiswick Wharf for Circular Quay at 6.20am and the first service from Circular Quay arrives at Chiswick at 6.10am.

Services will operate to the scheduled timetable which will be updated on 31 July. Customers can visit [transportnsw.info](http://transportnsw.info) or call **Transport Info** on **131 500** for timetable and service information.

### Landside work

We want to make sure customers can catch ferry services as soon as possible so we will be opening the new wharf and pathway ahead of the lighting being upgraded in Blackwell Point Reserve.

**A date for the park lighting installation will be advised shortly and access to the park and wharf will be maintained throughout this work.**

The wharf has been upgraded as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure. The new Chiswick Wharf will improve safety, accessibility and comfort for customers and make boarding and disembarking quicker and easier.
