

# City West Link improvement work

Traffic changes from Sunday 9 December



Dobroyd Parade

Roads and Maritime Services is increasing the capacity of City West Link by adding an additional eastbound lane between Waratah Street at Haberfield and James Street at Leichhardt.

The improvement of this two kilometre section of City West Link will:

- help ease existing congestion and improve traffic flow
- provide better network integration between City West Link and the New M4 project
- have capacity for five lanes, three eastbound and two westbound.

## The work

Roads and Maritime will be opening an additional eastbound lane on City West Link between Haberfield and Leichhardt from Sunday, 9 December, weather permitting.

We will continue to carry out finalisation work such as line-marking, upgrading traffic signals and re-surfacing the road. The work is expected to be complete in early 2019, weather permitting.

We have included a map to show the location of the works.

## Our work schedule

Most of the work will be carried out at night between:

- 8pm and 6am, Monday to Friday
- 8pm and 8am, Saturday
- 8pm and 9am, Sunday.

We will be working at different locations along City West Link to minimise disruption to residents, and will not work more than two consecutive nights in one week at the same location.



## How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact.

Where possible, noisier tasks will be completed before midnight. Work may extend to 1am for no more than one night a week between Wednesday and Friday.

Where possible, temporary noise barriers will be installed next to the noisier activities and only low noise reverse alarms will be used on trucks.

Vehicles and machinery will be switched off when not in use.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
