

New and extended clearways on Cleveland Street

City Road, Camperdown to Anzac Parade, Moore Park

Project Update - December 2017


The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$121 million Clearways Program, which aims to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads.

Roads and Maritime Services is extending the existing weekday clearway hours and introducing new weekend clearways on Cleveland Street between City Road and Anzac Parade. To make it easier for motorists the parking signposting on Cleveland Street is being simplified with clearways operating from 6am to 7pm every day. The clearways hours are shown on the map below.

There will be no changes to existing restrictions outside the new clearway hours.

What happens next?

The new weekend clearways and extended weekday clearways will be operational in **February 2018**. We will inform you again before we start work.



What is a clearway?

A clearway is a section of road where stopping and parking is not allowed during the times shown on the clearway sign. Clearways are put on key arterial roads where traffic is often heavy and congested. They help keep vehicles moving by making all lanes available to motorists. The only exception is the stopping of buses and taxis dropping off or picking up passengers as well as emergency vehicles. If you park in a clearway during the clearway hours you risk being fined and your vehicle can be towed.

Business customer parking

Currently on-street business customer parking is limited to a few sections of Cleveland Street and is only available between 7pm and 6am on weekdays and 6.30pm and 6.30am on weekends.

When the new clearway is implemented, parking in these sections will be available between 7pm and 6am every day. This should make it easier for everyone to understand.

Special event clearways will continue to operate along Cleveland Street as required.

As a resident or visitor, what does this mean for me?

The new weekend and extended weekday clearways will change parking conditions in front of residential and business properties along Cleveland Street. We understand that this may cause some inconvenience to you.

If you have a business or currently live on this section of Cleveland Street, you will need to reconsider where you and your visitors park during the new clearways hours. If you do not have a driveway, garage or carport on your property, local streets are available for you to park subject to council restrictions. Outside the clearway hours, existing parking restrictions will remain in place. As clearways continue to be rolled out across Sydney, you, your family and friends will experience more efficient, safer, and more reliable journey times. This means less time in the car, and more time doing the things you enjoy.
