Devlin Street southbound retaining wall work from Tuesday 9 November

November 2021

The Australian and NSW Governments are taking action to improve Sydney’s Road network, ease congestion and improve traffic flow, travel times and road safety.

Transport for NSW will continue to construct the new southbound lanes of Devlin Street, Ryde, as part of the Devlin Street improvements. We will also upgrade the retaining wall southbound along Devlin Street to enhance the safety of our improvements.

From Tuesday 9 November we will start temporary early works in preparation for the retaining wall upgrade. These works will include installing fencing, erosions and sediment controls, ground investigation, excavating and removing the existing wall, and ground stabilisation.

From **Sunday 28 November** we will start work to:

- build a stronger retaining wall
- install new overhead signage.

Our work schedule

To minimise the impact on the road network and reduce safety risks to workers and road users we will carry out most of the activities at night. We will undertake day work when possible.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from Sunday to Friday. We will work a maximum of 5 nights per week. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from Monday to Friday and **8am** to **1pm** on Saturdays. We will not work on public holidays.



How the retaining wall work will affect you

We will do everything we can to lessen the disruption, including:

- completing the noisiest night work activities by **midnight**.
- at night, accessing the work area from Devlin Street only, to minimise the impact to residents on Church Lane.
- during the day, accessing the work site via Church Lane, Ryde.

There will be temporary traffic changes on Devlin Street during our work hours to make the work zone safe.
