
Establishing a site compound at 166a Epping Road, North Ryde from Monday 16 November

The Australian and NSW Governments are taking action to improve Sydney’s road network, easing congestion and improving traffic flow, travel times and road safety.

In October 2020, the Australian and NSW Governments started work improving the intersection at Devlin Street, Blaxland Road and Parkes Street, Ryde. As part of this work we will be widening Devlin Street to add a fourth northbound lane between Victoria Road and Blaxland Road.

For this work we need to establish a site compound at 166a Epping Road, North Ryde to store materials and equipment.

This site compound will be used until the project is completed in late 2022.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for **5 day/night shifts** between **Monday 16 November** and **Friday 20 November** weather permitting to establish the site compound.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Monday** to **Friday** and on **Saturdays** between **8am** and **1pm**.

We will be accessing the site compound up to six days and five nights per week from **Sunday 22 November**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

How the work will affect you

While we establish the site compound, our work will be noisy and dusty. We will do everything we can to minimise our impact, such as ensuring machines and vehicles are turned off when not in use, limiting the use of the compound to vehicles only at night, completing noisy tasks by midnight and using water to control dust.

How the site compound will affect you

We will do everything we can to minimise impact to neighbours when we use the site compound, particularly in relation to noise and light spill.

When we are undertaking night works, we will need to use the site compound at night. We will do what we can such as installing hoarding around the site to reduce the impact of lights, direct lights away from neighbouring properties where possible, ensure vehicles and equipment are turned off when they aren't in use and require workers when they use the site to be considerate of neighbours.

We will keep you informed of the progress of our work.
