Utility investigations in Epping Town Centre

The NSW Government is funding a proposal to upgrade roads and intersections in Epping to improve traffic flow, reduce traffic delays and improve road safety as part of the Epping Town Centre Urban Activation Precincts Program.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out essential utility investigations **from Monday 9 March to Thursday 23 April, excluding Saturdays and Sundays**, weather permitting. Investigations will be carried out between 8am and 3pm. Some night work will also be required between 8pm and 5am, however this will be kept to a maximum of five shifts. Residents located near the night work will be contacted directly about the timing and duration of the investigations.

This work will involve drilling small holes at locations on Essex Street, Epping Road, Forest Grove and Blaxland Road to confirm the location of underground utilities including water mains and electrical cables. Equipment will include concrete saws, jackhammers, hand-held detection kit and construction vehicles. We have provided a map to help better explain the locations of the utility investigations.


Lane closures will be in place while the work is carried out to ensure the safety of road users and our workers. Road users are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.
