

## Night work at Ewingsdale Road interchange, Pacific Highway starting Tuesday 24 November

The NSW Government is investing in a project at the Ewingsdale Road interchange on the Pacific Highway to manage traffic flow and reduce highway congestion during peak traffic periods for motorists travelling to Ewingsdale and Byron Bay.

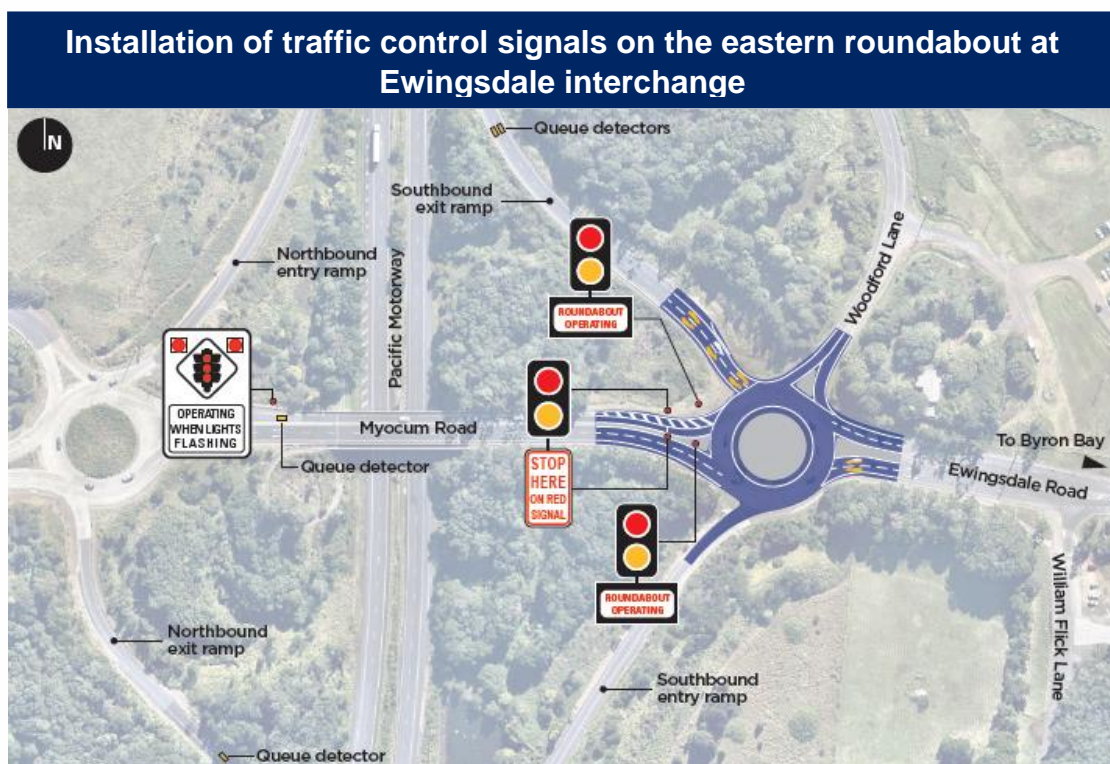
Transport for NSW is carrying out work to install traffic control signals on the eastern roundabout of the Ewingsdale interchange.

Site set up will take place on Tuesday 24 November between 7am and 5pm.

Due to high volumes of traffic, the remainder of the work will be carried out from Wednesday 25 November between 6pm and 3am, weather permitting and take about five weeks to complete. No work will take place on Saturday or Sunday nights.

We have included a map to show the location of the project.

We will let you know in advance if we need to work outside these times.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise and vibration. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning machinery off when not in use, positioning machinery away from residential areas and where possible start noisy activities later in the morning.

Access to properties in the area will be maintained at all times.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work area is safe.

In the work areas, traffic will be reduced to one lane with a reduced speed limit in place, which may affect travel times.
