

F6 Extension Stage 1 – Geotechnical investigations

The NSW government is progressing with the development of the F6 Extension Stage 1 between the New M5, Arncliffe and President Avenue, Kogarah.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out geotechnical investigation work to gather information about the ground conditions within the F6 Extension project area. Our advisors have selected several sites between Arncliffe and Kogarah. We have included a map to show the approximate location of the investigation work in Shaaron Court, Banksia.

The investigation work will start from **Monday 15 January** and will be completed by **Friday 2 February, 2018** (weather permitting). The work will take place between **7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday** and on **Saturdays between 8am and 1pm, excluding public holidays**.

The work will take about three weeks to complete.

How will the work affect you?

To ensure the work zone is safe, Roads and Maritime will install temporary fencing and traffic cones in Shaaron Court for the duration of the drilling work. This fencing will affect garbage and recycling truck access to Shaaron Court.

There will be some parking restrictions in place on Spring Street, in front of Beehag Reserve, to accommodate garbage and recycling bins from Shaaron Court. This will affect parking on the following dates for a maximum 24 hours from 4pm:

- **Wednesday 17 to Thursday 18 January**
- **Wednesday 24 to Thursday 25 January**
- **Wednesday 31 to Thursday 1 February, 2018.**

What does the work involve?

The work includes drilling a borehole and extracting soil samples using borehole drilling equipment. The work requires light vehicles and a trailer mounted generator. Heavy vehicles will not be used.

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will do everything we can to minimise its impact, and we will try to minimise the disturbance to the local community.

The location of these tests does not indicate a possible alignment. The work is designed to gather information about rock strata and conditions deep below the ground.
