Proposed F6 extension – gravity survey investigations

The NSW Government is funding investigations, including gravity surveys along the proposed corridor for the F6 extension.

Roads and Maritime Services conducts gravity surveys to gather information about the underground gravity and rock conditions near a proposed project area. Information from this work will be used to inform the engineering design, environmental planning and construction methodology.

Roads and Maritime Services is seeking permission to access your property to carry out gravity surveys. This survey is non-invasive, will have no impact on your property or access and will generally be completed within a few hours.

Work will include using a gravimeter to measure the downward acceleration of gravity in the outdoor area of your property. The work will be carried out on a date and time convenient to you between **7am and 4pm, Monday to Friday**.

Field staff will carry photo identification.

If you permit access to your property, the commencement of survey work will be by agreement with the property owner or property manager. You will be contacted at least 24 hours in advance before the survey work starts.

How do you agree to provide access to your property?

We have included a **property access agreement form** for you to complete. This is to provide the consultant permission to access your property to conduct the gravity surveying and will assist our team to understand your needs.

It will also help us to minimise any disturbance to you and ensure we address any special considerations or conditions of entry onto your property.
