SEPTEMBER 2010 ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Part 3A Order gazetted.

DECEMBER 2010

RMS prepares and submits a major project application to the Director-General of the Department of Planning and Infrastructure.

JANUARY 2011

Department of Planning and Infrastructure confirms assessment under Part 3A and consults relevant government agencies.  
Planning focus meeting held.

FEBRUARY 2011

Director-General provides environmental assessment requirements (DGRs).

Preparation of environmental assessment including draft statement of commitments.

SEPTEMBER 2012

RMS submits environmental assessment to Director-General for adequacy.

### EXHIBITION AND CONSULTATION

Director-General considers whether the environmental assessment adequately addresses the DGRs.

NOVEMBER 2012

Environmental assessment placed on public exhibition (30 days).

JANUARY 2013

At the completion of exhibition period, the Director-General provided RMS with a copy of submissions.

MAY 2013

RMS prepares a submissions report/revised statement of commitments/ preferred project report if required by the Director-General.

### ASSESSMENT AND DETERMINATION

Assessment report prepared by the Director-General.

Preferred project report (if required) may be exhibited if significant changes to the nature of the project are proposed.

Minister for Planning and Infrastructure considers any advice from Minister for Roads and Ports.

JULY 2013

Minister for Planning and Infrastructure approves the project and advises of the conditions attached to the approval.
