

Gerringong upgrade

Gerringong railway station - car park upgrade.

The NSW Government is funding the \$329 million Princes Highway upgrade at Gerringong to improve road safety and traffic efficiency. Completion is expected mid 2015.

As part of the Gerringong upgrade, the car park at Gerringong railway station will be upgraded to improve access and parking. This work is expected to start on Tuesday 17 February 2015 and will be done during standard working hours, Mondays to Fridays between 6.30am and 7pm. Work is expected to be completed in about three weeks, weather permitting.

The car park upgrade includes building a bus turning facility, 16 parking spaces and a new footpath for commuters. Please see overleaf, a map showing the upgrade design.

During the work, there will be reduced spaces for parking. Pedestrian access will be provided to the railway station at all times.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help motorists and pedestrians.
