## **Night work at the intersection of the Great Western Highway and Ross Street, Glenbrook from Thursday 12 July**

**The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the Glenbrook intersection upgrade as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan, a \$3.6 billion road investment program.**

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading the intersection of the Great Western Highway and Ross Street, Glenbrook to reduce congestion in the area and improve safety for pedestrians and motorists.

To minimise the impact on road users, some of this work will take place at night.

Night work includes:

- modifying the centre median strip on the Great Western Highway between Ross Street and Hare Street
- modifying the stormwater line next to the median strip
- reinstating road pavement next to the median strip.

We will be working up to five nights a week between **8pm** and **5am** from **Thursday 12 July to Sunday 12 August**, weather permitting.

Additional work will take place during standard construction hours, between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**.

The attached map shows the location of the night work.

### **How will the work affect you?**

Our work may be noisy but every effort will be made to minimise impacts on residents by:

- completing the noisier work earlier in the night
- turning off machinery when not in use
- monitoring noise at night.

### **Traffic changes**

Traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zones are safe for road users and workers. The speed limit on the Great Western Highway between Ross Street and Hare Street, Glenbrook will be **reduced to 60 km/h, 24 hours a day, seven days a week** until project completion at the end of 2018, weather permitting.

Speed limits will be further reduced to **40 km/h** during night work.

These changes may affect travel times. Please be aware of pedestrians and cyclists when travelling through the work area. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.


