

Out of hours work on Great Western Highway, Medlow Bath from Monday 11 January

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade Program.

Transport for NSW will carry out safety improvements on the Great Western Highway at the intersections with Bellevue Crescent and Foy Avenue, to provide dedicated right hand turn and through lanes.



Transport for NSW will carry out this work, which includes the removal of select trees to enable shoulder widening and the elimination of crash hazards near the travel lanes. The map above shows the area of the work, highlighted in blue.

There will be up to **15 shifts of night work** between **Monday 11 January** and **Wednesday 31 March**, however **this may change due to weather and environmental conditions**.

Our work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am Sunday to Friday**. We will work up to five night shifts nights per week.

By working five nights per week we can reduce the overall length of our work and limit the impact to the local community.

We will notify you in advance if we need to do any work outside of these hours.

How will the work affect you?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained during the work. Where possible, we will make every effort to minimise impacts. There may be some changes to driveway access during the work. For affected properties, residents will be contacted individually and traffic control will be on site to assist.

It may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight** and moving trees to the compound site to mulch during the day.

Transport for NSW has undertaken an environment assessment regarding the impacts of these works and will be planting new trees to offset those being removed.

Traffic changes

A reduced speed limit of 40 km/h and traffic controls will be in place during night work hours for the safety of road users and workers.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, allow extra time and follow the direction of signs and traffic control.
