

## Investigation works, Great Western Highway, Little Hartley to Lithgow, from March to July 2021

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade Program.

Transport for NSW will carry out various investigations, including geotechnical surveys, Aboriginal cultural heritage assessments, biodiversity studies, noise monitoring, traffic studies and environmental surveys on the Great Western Highway over the coming five months to inform the design of the Highway upgrade.

### Location of work on Great Western Highway, Little Hartley to Lithgow



Contractors for Transport for NSW will carry out this work along the Great Western Highway and on private properties between March and July 2021. The map above shows the area of the work, highlighted in blue.

Work will begin in mid-March March 2021 and finish by July 2021, however this may change due to weather and environmental conditions.

Our work hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 2pm on Saturdays.**

We will notify you in advance if we need to do any work outside of these hours.

## How will the work affect you?

If we require access to your property for investigations, you will be contacted by Transport for NSW to discuss the work, obtain permission, and arrange a suitable time for access.

The investigation work involves site surveys and field work and is generally non-invasive. At times, however, a drilling rig or excavator may be required to obtain soil and rock samples. You will be advised if this is required on your property.

We will make every effort to minimise impacts. Access to your property will be maintained at all times unless alternative arrangements are discussed directly with you.

## Traffic changes

Work will primarily be carried out beside the road, however there may be some minor traffic delays if work is occurring in the road corridor.

A reduced speed limit of 40km/h and traffic controls may be in place during work hours for the safety of road users and workers. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, allow extra time and follow the direction of signs and traffic control.
