

Noise wall work for Heathcote Road upgrade from Thursday 15 July

The NSW Government is upgrading the 2.2 kilometre section of Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and The Avenue, Voyager Point to help reduce congestion, improve road safety and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

Transport for NSW will carry out work on noise walls for the Heathcote Road upgrade between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and The Avenue, Voyager Point. We have awarded a contract to SD Group build the project's first two noise walls.

We began carrying out investigation activities in June and work to start building the noise walls will follow on site from **Thursday 15 July**. These activities will include:

- removing trees, shrubs and other vegetation from the area where noise walls will be built
- establishing the site compound north of Harris Creek to support the noise wall construction
- removing topsoil
- excavating for footings and installing steel columns and concrete footings
- installing noise wall concrete panels
- landscaping in front of the noise walls.

How will the work affect you?

Our construction work for the upgrade will involve the use of machinery and equipment which will generate some dust and noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Our work schedule

We will start work from **Thursday 15 July**.

Our work hours will be from **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm**.

We will continue to update the community about our work schedule.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

While we build these noise walls, there will need to be some changes to where pedestrians can walk between Infantry Parade and Holsworthy Train Station. Safe pedestrian detours will be in place at all times.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place around the work zone during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.



Heathcote Road upgrade

Transport for NSW is carrying out this work as part of Stage 1 of the upgrade to assist with addressing some safety issues in the area early in the project construction. The Stage 1 upgrade work includes:

- Installing temporary traffic lights at the intersection of The Avenue at Voyager Point
- Building two of the project's noise walls:
 - Noise wall 1 (80 metres) near the childcare centre near Infantry Parade.
 - Noise wall 2 (250 metres) between Macarthur Drive and Harris Creek.

We expect to complete this work in December 2021, weather permitting.
