

Field investigation work on Henry Lawson Drive at the intersection of Rabaul Road, Georges Hall from Monday 6 March

The NSW Government is funding this investigation work as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Points Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out geotechnical investigation work, which includes drilling holes and then reinstating the pavement. To minimise the impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, some of this work will be carried out at night.

The work will take place at the intersection of Henry Lawson Drive and Rabaul Road, Georges Hall.

We have included a map to help explain the location of the work.

The investigation work will be carried out between **Monday 6 March** and **Friday 10 March**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **8pm** to **5am**. We expect night work to take about **two shifts** to complete.

Some work will also be carried out during the day. Our working hours will be from **7am** to **6pm**.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated the work but we will complete it as quickly as possible to minimise any disruptions.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures may be in place and will affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
