

# Overnight work on Parramatta Road, Lidcombe, and Hill Road, Sydney Olympic Park

## Transport for NSW | April 2021

Transport for NSW will undertake periodic investigation work on Parramatta Road, Lidcombe, and Hill Road, in Sydney Olympic Park, between April and June 2021.

The work is located on or in the vicinity of:

- Parramatta Road and Bombay Street, Lidcombe
- Parramatta Road and Birnie Avenue, Lidcombe
- along Hill Road and John Ian Wing Parade, Carter Street and the M4 eastbound off ramp, at Sydney Olympic Park and Lidcombe.

The work will take up to 25 night shifts over a four-week period, beginning on **12 April 2021**, weather permitting. We will be on site for up to five nights a week, between Sunday and Thursday, between **9pm and 5am**.

The work involves drilling and concrete cutting, as well as reinstating the road pavement when complete. The work will assist Transport for NSW in developing designs for the proposed Hill Road upgrade.

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities (such as drilling and concrete cutting) by 11pm.


### Traffic changes
