

Night work on Swansea Bridge, Swansea from Monday 18 October

The NSW Government is funding essential biannual maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes inspecting and testing the electrical, mechanical and hydraulic components and the emergency systems of the bridge. We will also be carrying out concrete repair works and maintenance work to the bridge opening span deck, bridge centre locks and barriers.

We will be working on the southbound bridge from **Monday 18 October** to **Wednesday 20 October** between **7pm** and **5am** and expect to complete the work in **three nights**, weather permitting. We will then be working on the northbound bridge on **Thursday 21 October** between **7pm** and **5am** and expect to complete the work in **one** night, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

One bridge will remain open at all times, operating with one lane in each direction while the maintenance work is being carried out. The southbound bridge will be closed at night during work hours from Monday 18 October to Wednesday 20 October. The northbound bridge will be closed at night during work hours on Thursday 21 October.

Traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists.

The bridge will not be open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.


