

Night work continuing on Memorial Avenue at Kellyville from 4 October

September 2022

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to ease congestion, improve travel times and meet the future transport needs for Sydney’s growing north west.

What are we doing?

We will carry out the following works:

- utility services relocation and installation
- temporary road pavement and asphaltting work
- installation of stormwater drainage
- service investigation.

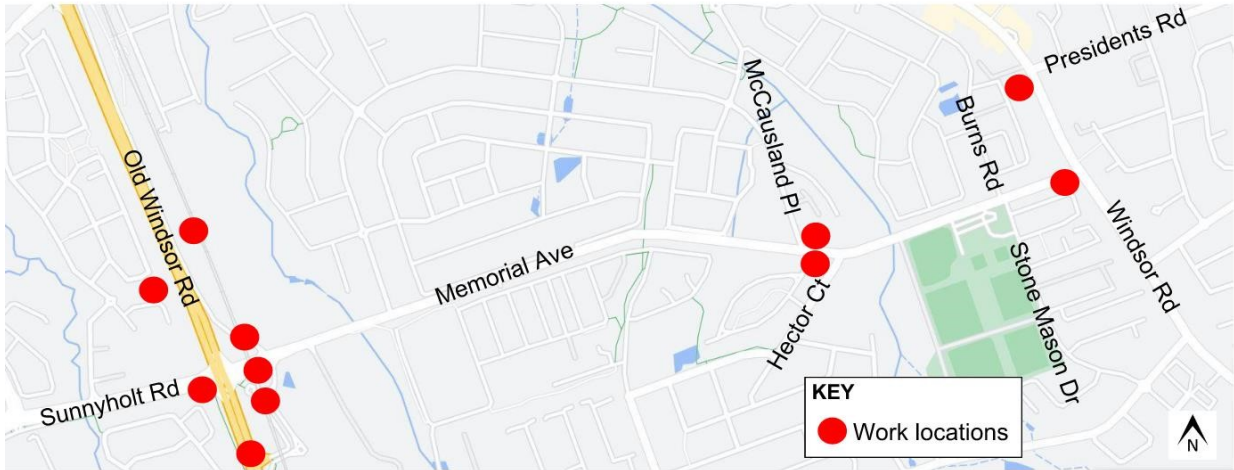
Our work schedule

Night work will take place **between Tuesday 4 October and Monday 31 October** in the following areas, weather permitting.

Activity	Duration
Utility services road crossing (electrical) on Memorial Avenue at the intersection with Windsor Road	1 x 2 nights
Utility services installation (street lighting) on the eastern side of Windsor Road near the intersection of Presidents Road	2 x 2 nights
Utility services under bore (water) on Windsor Road between Presidents Road and Memorial Avenue	2 x 2 nights
Temporary pavement works, asphaltting and line marking on Memorial Avenue, between McCausland Place and Hector Court	3 x 2 nights
Removal of existing pedestrian island and install temporary pavement and traffic signals on Memorial Avenue at the T-Way	2 x 2 nights
Installation of stormwater on Old Windsor Road, north of the Memorial Avenue intersection	1 x 5 nights
Installation of stormwater on Memorial Avenue across the T-Way	2 x 2 nights
Installation of stormwater near the intersection of Old Windsor Road and Memorial Avenue under the Sydney Metro Viaduct	2 x 2 nights
Installation of stormwater on Old Windsor Road near the T-Way car park entrance	2 x 2 nights
Services investigation work at different locations along Memorial Avenue, Old Windsor Road and Windsor Road	No more than 2 nights at one location

Our night work hours are **from 8pm to 5am Sunday to Friday**. However, our work crews may be on site **from 6pm** to prepare for the shift and set up safety equipment.

How will the work affect you?

We will be completing our work at night to reduce traffic disruption and any risks to the workers and road users during the day. The night work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing noisier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.
