

## Night work on Memorial Avenue at Kellyville from Sunday 2 May 2021

The NSW Government is upgrading Memorial Avenue to ease congestion, improve travel times and meet the future transport needs for Sydney's growing northwest.

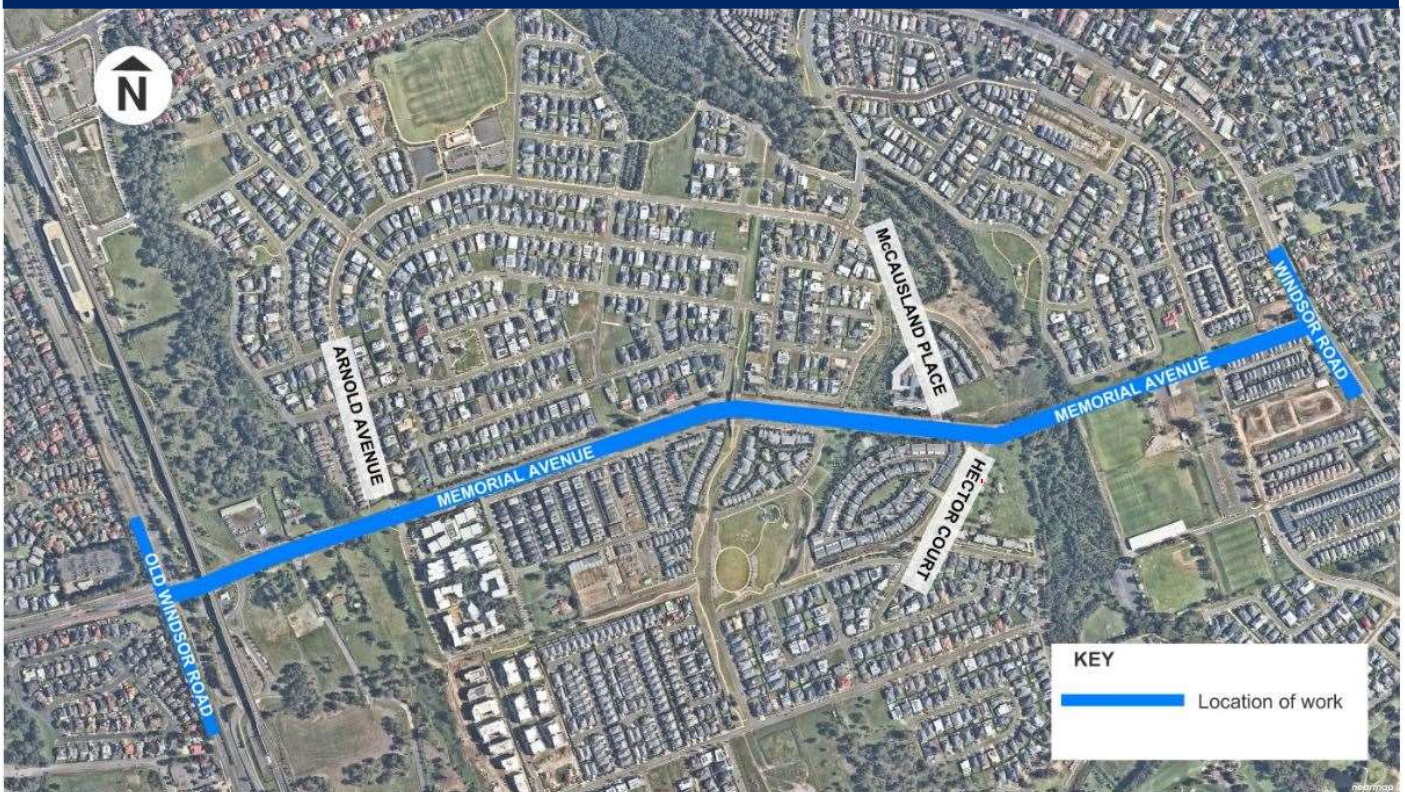
Night work will be carried out for the upgrade during **May** between **8pm** and **5am Sunday to Friday**, weather permitting.

Residents and businesses will be directly notified in advance of any out of hours work near their property.

Night work in May includes:

- installing temporary traffic signs
- site preparation and installation of safety barriers
- survey and utility investigations
- clearing vegetation within the work area

## Our work schedule

Our normal construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday**. We will be working up to five nights per week but no more than two nights in one location, without prior consultation with directly affected neighbours

We will not work on public holidays.

## What are we doing?

We will continue night work during May to place concrete safety barriers, install signage, clear vegetation within the work area and conduct investigations for underground utility locations.

We need to carry out this work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce any risks to the workers and road users during the day.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday**, however our work crews may be on site from 6pm to prepare for the shift and set up safety equipment.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to minimise noise where possible by staging the work along different parts of the work zone to minimise disruption in the same area and turning off vehicles when not in use.

Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place. Travel times may be affected by up to five minutes.
