
Scope changes

Transport for NSW has made scope changes on Connells Point Road in response to feedback outlined in the consultation report dated February 2021 and the completion of further assessments of the original proposed scope of work. Transport for NSW is planning to carry out this work along Connells Point Road in early 2022.

Scope change on Connells Point Road (west)

Since our last notification, Transport for NSW has completed further planning work aimed at improving safety by introducing the following scope:

- Relocate and consolidate bus stops (2221129 and 222195). The new bus stop will require the removal of three parking spaces and be located west of The Mall.



Scope changes on Connells Point Road (east)



Proposed Scope on Connells Point Road (east)

In March 2021, Transport for NSW committed to reviewing the proposal. Following further investigations, Transport for NSW is proposing the following scope, to achieve a balance between parking needs and traffic flow:

- Right turn bay from Connells Point Road onto King Georges Road north extended by 56 metres during peak periods
- About nine parking spaces converted to 'no stopping' during weekday peak periods to allow for extension of right turn bay and through traffic movement.
