

Field investigations on Princes Highway, Blakehurst from Monday 27 March 2017.

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$300 million Gateway to the South Pinch Points Program which will improve traffic flow on Sydney's key southern road corridors by upgrading major intersections.

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out geotechnical and utility investigation works, which include drilling, locating and testing utilities, and reinstating the pavement. To minimise the impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, most of this work will be carried out at night.

The investigation work will take place along Princes Highway, from the intersection with King Georges Road and Stuart Street, to about 50 metres south of the intersection with Torrens Street.

We will be carrying out the work between **Monday 27 March 2017** and **Friday 21 April 2017**, weather permitting and excluding public holidays. The work will take about **5 shifts** to complete. Our working hours will be from **9.30pm** to **4am**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures may be in place and will affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
