

Preparation for utility relocations on Thule Road from 14 April

The NSW Government is continuing planning for a new bridge over the Clyde River at Nelligen

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which involves drilling holes into the ground to install pipes that will later carry relocated utilities including telecommunications under Thule Road. Once work is completed, any disturbed areas will be restored.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm, Monday to Friday** from **14 April** and expect to complete the work in **three weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

Thule Road will need to be closed either east or west of Bridgeview Road (depending on work location) during daytime work hours (7am till 6pm) but will be re-opened at night. The closure will involve a detour and residents will always have access from one end of Thule Road via the detour. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

Traffic control will be in place during work hours to direct motorists to the appropriate Thule Road entry.


