

Kingsford to Centennial Park walking and cycling improvements

Temporary Night Works and Road Closure

Transport for NSW | November 2022

The Australian and NSW Governments are delivering walking and cycling improvements to provide an active transit link between Kingsford and Centennial Park.

Upcoming work

Commencing **Monday 14 November**, up to ten night shifts of work is required to construct new stormwater drainage along Doncaster Avenue at the intersection of Day Avenue, Kensington.

To complete this work, the intersection at Doncaster Avenue and Day Avenue will be temporarily closed during these work nights.

We anticipate the detour will be implemented from **Monday 21 November**.

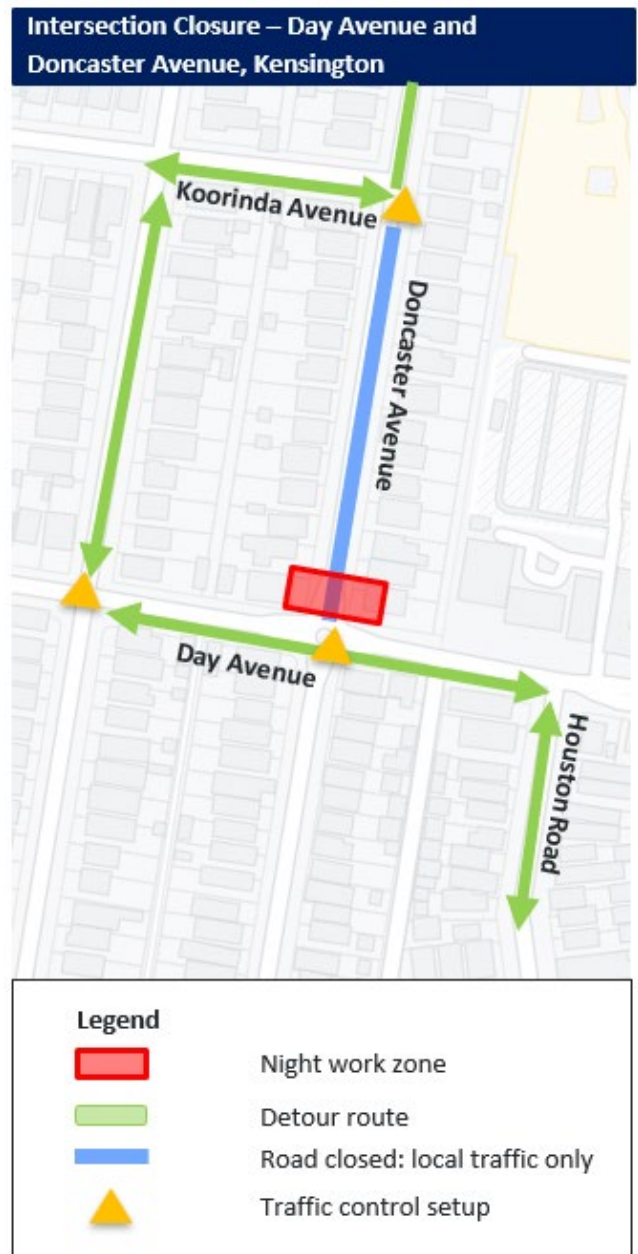
Detours will be in place to ensure the safety of road users, pedestrians and our workers. The map shows the road closure locations and planned detour routes.

Local access to properties will be maintained for residents and businesses.

Work hours

Our work hours will be from **7pm to 5am** for up to ten nights.

Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Minimising community impact

Our work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise, light, and vibration. Equipment used for these activities include saw-cutter, excavator, concrete truck, compaction equipment, vacuum truck, mobile lighting towers, trucks, and excavators.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- complete noisiest activities such as saw-cutting and jackhammering by midnight
- Turn off machinery when not in use
- Use noise blankets to minimise noise, where feasible
- Direct temporary lighting down and away from houses
- Fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers
- Monitor noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required

We will work with residents in close proximity to these works to minimise impacts and we will notify you ahead of the work in your area

All work will be carried out in line with project environmental approvals.

Traffic, parking and pedestrian changes

There will be traffic changes and detours in place during our work to ensure the work zone is safe which may affect travel times.

There may be partial footpath closures near our work area and alternative path and signs will be in place.

Access to properties will be maintained for local residents and businesses. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.

There will be some temporary parking removal along Doncaster and Day Avenue while we construct the stormwater pipe. We will communicate with adjacent properties.

Our site compounds may be used during our standard and out of hours work and plant and machinery may be used during this time.
