Start of work on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road, Kooragang from Wednesday 16 September 2015

The Australian and NSW governments have each committed \$51.9 million for this project to improve traffic flow and cater for future traffic growth.

Roads and Maritime Services is starting a package of enabling work for the upgrade before inviting tenders for the main construction contract later this year. The enabling work will allow construction to start shortly after the contract is awarded to the successful tenderer.

The enabling work will include building road embankments at the southern end of the Tourle Street Bridge and in the Long Pond area on the northern side of Cormorant Road, utility adjustments and the construction of an underground barrier to prevent movement of contaminants from the old steelworks.

We will be working **Monday to Friday** between **6am and 6pm** and **Saturdays** between **7am and 2pm**. Night work is scheduled to start on **Wednesday 16 September** and will be carried out **Sunday to Friday** between **7:30pm and 4:30am**, weather permitting. The first program of night work activities is expected to take **four weeks** to complete, with further night work to be scheduled as work progresses.

We expect to complete the enabling work by early 2016, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to minimise noise, including arranging the work in stages at different locations. Where possible, obstructions to driveways and parking will be minimised.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Reduced speed limits will be in place throughout the enabling work and temporary lane closures will be in place during night work activities. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
