Night work and extended weekend hours on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road, Kooragang, from Thursday 1 February 2018

The Australian and NSW governments have each committed funding for this project to improve traffic flow and cater for future traffic growth.

Roads and Maritime Services is duplicating 3.8 kilometres of Tourle Street and Cormorant Road between Industrial Drive, Mayfield West and Egret Street, Kooragang. This work includes the construction of a second bridge over the Hunter River.

Upcoming work:

- temporary line marking for changed traffic conditions
- installing new safety barriers
- road construction and surfacing activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road
- progressing the new bridge
- utilities, drainage and concreting activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some of the work will be carried out at night and outside standard working hours.

Night work will be occasionally happen between **6pm** and **7am**, from **Thursday 1 February** and **continue for two months**, weather permitting.

We will be working extended weekend hours between **7am** and **6pm** from **Saturday 3 February** to **Sunday 1 April 2018**, weather permitting.

We will continue to deliver the majority of work between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Monday** to **Friday**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise related to this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- arranging the work in stages at different locations
- using the minimum amount of machinery necessary and turning it off when not in use.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will continue to be in place to ensure the work area is safe.

Lane closures may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers, traffic lights and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
