


Road rebuilding on Lismore Bangalow Road near Bexhill from Monday 16 September

As part of the Safer Roads Program, the NSW Government is funding essential work to improve the road surface and safety on Lismore Bangalow Road, north of Eltham Road.

Roads and Maritime Services has engaged Lismore City Council to carry out upgrades to a series of sections on the Lismore to Bangalow Road.

The next project is to complete work on a 2.1km section of Lismore Bangalow Road north-east of Bexhill. The work will involve road rebuilding, widening shoulders and installing additional guardrail and new drainage to improve safety.

Stage one of this project, which involved rebuilding a 700-metre section of the road, was completed in early August. Stage two is scheduled to start on **Monday 16 September** and will take **six months** to complete, weather permitting. We will be working between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Saturday**.



The work will take place progressively in two stages north of Eltham Road:

- Stage 1 - completed August 2019
- Stage 2 - starting Monday 9 September 2019

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning machinery off when not in use and positioning machinery away from residential areas where possible.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Traffic changes

Traffic will be reduced to one lane, alternate flow during work hours. This arrangement may also be implemented outside of work hours as required. Traffic control and a reduced speed limit will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists. Motorists are advised to plan their journey, allow extra travel time and follow all signs.
