## Road rebuilding on Lismore Bangalow Road, Clunes from Monday 14 October

The NSW Government is providing \$11 million to improve the road surface and safety on Lismore Bangalow Road at Clunes. The work is being funded from a range of programs, including the Safer Roads Program.


The need for this work was identified in the Lismore Bangalow Road Corridor Strategy, which outlines plans to improve safety and efficiency on this important road.

Stage one of the work will involve rebuilding the road surface and widening the road shoulders on a 1.2 kilometre section of road to the east of James Gibson Road.

Stage two will involve building an overtaking lane between Eureka and Springvale roads.

Early work for stage one started on Tuesday 1 October and involved setting up the site. Changes to traffic are expected to start on Monday 14 October. We will be working **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**, and **Saturday** between **8am** and **5pm**. Stage one is expected to be completed by June 2020.

We have included a map to show the location of work for stage one.



## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning machinery off when not in use and positioning machinery away from residential areas where possible.

Access to properties in the area will be maintained at all times.

## Traffic changes

Work to improve the road surface also continues on Lismore Bangalow Road east of Bexhill near Eltham Road. Traffic will be reduced to one lane alternate flow during work hours at both the Bexhill work site and east of James Gibson Road. Reduced speed limits will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists. Motorists are advised to plan their journey, allow extra travel time and follow all directions and signs.
