Out of hours work at the ancillary facility for the M1 Pacific Motorway upgrade between Kariong and Somersby from Tuesday 29 January

The Australian and NSW governments are investing in the upgrade of the M1 Pacific Motorway between the Kariong and Somersby interchanges to improve traffic flow and safety.

Roads and Maritime Services has awarded a contract to Fulton Hogan Construction to widen the motorway and upgrade three of the four ramps at the Kariong interchange.

The project is one of three M1 Pacific Motorway upgrades, providing a better and more reliable journey for people, businesses and heavy vehicles on one of Australia's busiest roads.

Major work is continuing and the temporary ancillary facility at Pile Road is used to stockpile material and produce concrete for pavement work.

With the increase in temperature during summer, Fulton Hogan will need to work earlier in the mornings so concrete can be placed during cooler times of the day. Out of hours work will be carried out where predicted high temperatures will be above average. Our current Environment Protection Licence allows this facility to operate up to two consecutive shifts outside of normal operation hours, with five nights of no work between another early out of hours shift.

During the out of hours work, the facility will operate between **4am and 8pm, Monday to Friday** and between **4am and 5pm on Saturdays** until **Saturday 30 March**. Dates will be determined by weather and an email and SMS service will be available to those wishing to be notified of the timing of out of hours work.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise from a loader and batching equipment, a concrete agitator or tipper trucks and light vehicles. Lighting will be directed away from residential properties.

We will make every effort to minimise noise and turn off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be no changes to the existing traffic arrangement in this area, however there will be an increase in light and heavy vehicle traffic to and from this facility during hours of operation. Vehicles will travel along Pile Road to Somersby Falls Road and then on to Wisemans Ferry Road to access the motorway.


